

18 November marks the Latvian National Days and the Independence Day.

Thailand and Latvia established their diplomatic relations on 19 March 1992 (29 years ago) and Thailand was among the first countries to officially recognize the republic of Latvia following the establishment of the Latvian state on 18 November 1918.

Currently, there are 32 Thais residing in Latvia. Most of them are working in the spa and massage business and many are married to the Latvian people. Though the number is not considered large, they play an important part in promoting Thai-Latvian relations.

The Embassy will work fully to enhance the relations between the two countries. We look forward to jointly celebrate the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries next year.
